AGM - UPDATE

I would like to welcome a new member to our executive, Annette Lebus, she will be our Director of Player Development.

We will once again, focus on the Spirit of Winter Tournament as being our major Fund Raiser next season and will not be selling Chocolate Bars. This will of course depend on a couple of things; one being that we have a volunteer willing to head the Tournament Committee and the other being that we get the ice we applied for. We did have interest from members that would like to be on the Committee but we do need to have a Chairperson before we can proceed. 13-16 2007. Should the Tournament proceed all teams will be asked to donate a basket for the Raffle Table and put in volunteer time at the tournament. A, B & C Provincial Tournament registration fees will only be paid after your **team** has put in 24 hours of association volunteer time, regular **team duties** will not be counted in a team's 24 hours.

At the AGM this season it was decided that the association will not longer apply for a Class B license so the teams can run 50/50 draws at their home games. Applying for the permit and maintaining the records is a lot of work for the association Treasurer. Fraser Valley teams will not be allowed to run 50/50 draws at their home games next season. Sorry for the inconvenience this may cause the teams.

We will however continue to apply for the permit to run 50/50 draws and a Raffle Table at the Tournament.

REGISTRATION 2007/2008

The fees will remain the same as last season. Early registration forms are included in with this newsletter. Register early and save \$50.00 per player. Early registration is \$310.00 for Novice, Petite, Tween, Junior, Belle and Open players and must be received by our registrar by June 1, 2007. All early registrations must be accompanied by full payment or three post-dated cheques:

1 st Installment	\$110.00	Dated June 1, 2007
2 nd Installment	\$100.00	Dated July 1, 2007
3 rd Installment	\$100.00	Dated Sept. 1, 2007

Bunnies are also welcome to register early but due to the already discounted rate of \$160.00 per player. There are no further discounts by registering early. If you choose to pay your Bunny registration fees by post-dated cheques please date them as follows:

1 st Installment	\$100.00	Dated Sept. 1, 2007
2 nd Installment	\$ 60.00	Dated Oct. 15, 2007

Early Registration not only saves you some money but it helps us get a head start on the season. We have very little time before the season starts to grade players and select our teams. Please help us by getting your registration in early. All players who are registered early will be notified of their first ice time for the 2007/2008 season, by telephone or email.

Those of you unable to register early will be able to register at Walnut Grove Sportsplex on Tuesday, September 4, 2007 where we will hold Registration along with our annual Equipment Swap from 5:00 and 7:00 pm.
