## REGISTRATION 2009/2010

Due to rising ice costs and the acquisition of new ice sheets over the past couple of seasons, registration fees will have to increase for the coming season. Register early and save \$50.00 per player. Early registration forms are included with this newsletter. Early registration will now be \$350.00 for Novice, Petite, Tween, Junior, Belle Open and Masters players and must be received by our registrar by July 1, 2009. All registrations must be accompanied by full payment or three post-dated cheques dated as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Installment	\$110.00	Dated July 1, 2009
2 <sup>nd</sup> Installment	\$120.00	Dated Aug. 1, 2009
3 <sup>rd</sup> Installment	\$120.00	Dated Sept. 1, 2009

Bunnies are also welcome to register early but due to the already discounted rate of \$175.00 per player, there are no further discounts by registering early. If you choose to pay your Bunny registration fees by post-dated cheque please date them as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Installment	\$100.00	Dated Sept. 1, 2009
2 <sup>nd</sup> Installment	\$ 75.00	Dated Oct. 15, 2009

On the back of the registration forms you will find the Player and Parent Code of Conduct forms, be sure to read and sign these forms before you send in your registration. Please include your jersey deposit cheque of \$150.00, dated May 1, 2010, with your completed registration. Early Registration not only saves you money but it helps us get a head start on the season. We have very little time before the season starts to grade players and select our teams. All players who are registered early will be notified of their first ice time by telephone or email. If you are unable to register early, you can register on Tuesday, September 8, 2009 at our annual Equipment Swap between 5:00 and 7:00 pm at W. G. Sportsplex. Novice-Masters regular fees will increase to \$400.00.

## AGM

We were disappointed with the attendance at our Annual General Meeting this year. The start of the meeting was delayed until we had enough attendees to meet our Quorum requirements. We do wish to thank all of the parents that were in attendance this year.

At this years AGM it was decided to increase registration fees for next season. Registration fees for Novice to Masters will increase by \$40.00 per player, regular registration will now be \$400.00 and early registration will be \$350.00. Bunny registration fees will increase by \$15.00 per player and will now be \$175.00 per player.

In another motion it was decided that we change the limit of referral refunds a player can claim. Each player is now eligible to receive one \$50.00 referral refund for each new player they encourage to join FV Ringette (only limited by the amount of their own registration fees).

We would like to thank Leanne Fawcett, Jasmine McGinn and Stacy Bellsmith for their years of service on our executive.

We have added a Director of Evaluations Position to our executive. We would like to welcome Rick Vanier, Wendy Keleny, Leanne Hattie, Jeaneen Briner, Trish Brown and Cherri Young to our executive. ## CALL FOR OFFICIALS

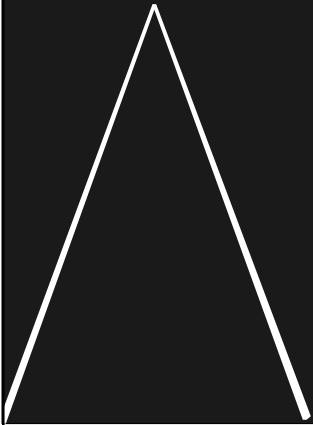
Fraser Valley Ringette generally trains about 4-5 new officials every season. Player officials are great but as they are still playing themselves scheduling can become a bit of a problem.
