Ringette is a Canadian sport that was invented in 1963 in North Bay, Ontario by the late Sam Jacks and it has become one of the fastest team sports played on ice There are currently nearly 30,000 players on more than 2,000 teams across Canada with over 1,500 officials and 8,000 coaches. Although it was invented as a winter team sport for girls, there are currently about 700 male athletes playing the sport. Internationally, it is played in many other countries around the world including Finland, Sweden, the United States of America, France, Slovakia, Russia, the Czech Republic, and Abu Dhabi. As part of the Sport for Life movement, Ringette is well advanced at adapting Sport Canada's Long Term Athlete Development model.
