Ringette is a Canadian sport invented in 1963 in North Bay, Ontario by the late Sam Jacks. It has become one of the fastest team sports on ice combining the speed of hockey with the strategy of basketball. There are nearly 30,000 players on more than 2,000 teams across Canada with over 1,500 officials & 8,000 coaches. Although it was invented as a winter team sport for girls, about 700 male athletes also play. Internationally, it is played in Finland, Sweden, the United States of America, France, Slovakia, Russia, the Czech Republic, and Abu Dhabi. As part of the Sport for Life movement, Ringette is well advanced at adapting Sport Canada's Long Term Athlete Development model.
